◆ Library Card

The Nagoya University ID card or the Library Card is necessary for borrowing materials from the Library.

- * Undergraduate and graduate students, faculty and staff members of Nagoya University may use Student ID card or Staff ID card as a Library Card.
- * Please make an application for a Library Card, in case your Student or Staff ID card does not contain a magnetic strip or the ID card isn't issued to you. It takes about a week and it's free of charge to make the card. Please ask at the Information Desk for further details.

◆ Circulation Policies

Material Type	Limit	Loan Period
Books	5 items	2 weeks
Bound journals	5 items	1 week
Unbound journals (published current and last year)	3 items	Overnight (12:00 – within 4 hours from the library's next open)
Videos	2 items	1 week

- * Some videos are not permitted to borrow.
- * Loan period can be renewed once if you bring materials on or before the due date.
- * You can't borrow reference books.
- * In case you fail to return the materials by the due date, borrowing rights are suspended for one week from the day you have returned the materials.
- * If you lose any books borrowed from the Library, please inform the Information Desk immediately.

◆ Arrangement of Books and Journals

The Library provides all bibliographic information by OPAC (Online Public Access Catalog).

Books accessioned before 1989 are shelved at electric shelves, and after 1990 are at fixed shelves. They are classified according to Nippon Decimal Classification system.

Journals are categorized according to the language (Japanese or Non-Japanese), divided into some parts by year of publication and arranged alphabetically.

ISI Web of Knowledge (※on campus only)

Web of Science: the citation database of multidisciplinary information. You can trace the history of development on certain research.

Journal Citation Reports (JCR): the analytical tool that provides the data to evaluate journals and their impact and influence. The Impact Factor, a unique evaluation feature, reveals a journal's importance relative to others in its field.

◆ Facilities in the Medical Library

PC Corner (2nd floor)

There are 12 Windows PCs, 5 Macintosh PCs and a color printer combined with a copier.

Undergraduate and graduate students of School of Medicine are given priority over others.

Computers are provided for library users to have access to the library networked information like OPAC, Electronic Journals and databases.

You can use them for the purpose of academic research, learning and teaching only.

Audiovisual Room (2nd floor)

You can use videos and CD-ROMs provided in the Library. Please make an application to use this room.

Newspaper Room (2nd floor)

Japanese newspapers, English newspaper (Japan Times), and magazines are available.

Display Case for Lost Article (2nd floor)

If you find your belongings inside the case, please come to the Information Desk with your ID card.

※ Personal belongings should not be left unattended. The Library won't have any responsibility for loss or damage of them.

Access to the LAN (2nd and 3rd floor)

The undergraduate and graduate students, faculty and staff members of School of Medicine and Nagoya University Hospital can get access to LAN from own laptop computer in this library.

Please ask at the Information Desk for further details.

Self-Service Photocopier (2nd and 3rd floor)

* 2nd floor

One copier accept Co-op copy cards. You can buy the card at the Co-op Store. Color copying is available.

* 3rd floor

One copier accept coins and two accept Co-op copy cards. Black and white copying only.

※ Copyright law should be strictly observed by all library users when making copies of library materials. Making copies for the purpose of your own research is permitted. Please don't copy personal belongings.

Exhibition Room (4th floor)

Historical materials about Nagoya University School of Medicine and Nagoya University Hospital are preserved and exhibited. Those who want to see the room need to apply to the Information Desk.

Seminar Room (4th floor)

Two rooms are available for group discussion. They can be reserved by undergraduate and graduate students of School of Medicine for four hours per day, up to one week in advance. Please make reservation at the Information Desk.

(Mon - Fri : 9:00 - 19:00)
(Sat : 13:00 - 17:00)

◆Book Purchase

Please apply at the Information Desk to recommend the purchase of the books for the Library collection. The librarians determine to purchase or not and notify the result on the board.

◆Inter-Library Loan : pay service

This service is for undergraduate and graduate students, faculty and staff members of School of Medicine and Nagoya University Hospital.

Materials not available in Tsurumai campus can be obtained from other libraries in Nagoya University or other universities.

Please make the application to the Information Desk. The application form is placed in front of the Information Desk.

	Receive duplication	5 days	20 yen per sheet
From other universities	Borrow books	10 days	postage
	Receive duplication	5 days	50 yen per sheet + postage

※ The above examples are average period and charge.

◆To visit libraries of other universities

Your ID card is necessary to visit libraries of other universities. Some libraries require you to bring a letter of introduction or to inquire beforehand. In such cases, contact the Information Desk at least a week in advance.

◆Overtime-Admission Card

Following members with the card are entitled to access the library during closed hours (Midnight to 4:00a.m.→ not accessible at all.);

-All students, faculty and staff members in the Graduate School of Medicine and Nagoya University Hospital

-3rd to 6th year students in the School of Medicine.

For those in need of the card, please come to the Information Desk of the Library to pick up the application form. To finish the application, you need to obtain the supervisor's approval stamp.

◆ Library Policy

*Library materials need to be put into place by users.

*Individuals will not leave personal belongings unattended. Such items will be removed by library staff.

*Eating is prohibited in the library.

*Drinking beverages is only allowed only from covered containers. Acceptable containers include plastic bottled with lids. Aluminum cans and paper cups are prohibited.

*Smoking is prohibited throughout the Library.

*Cell phones should be either set on vibration mode or turned off. Use of cell phones is restricted in the library.

*The Library seeks to provide a safe and secure environment suitable for reading, studying and other activities.

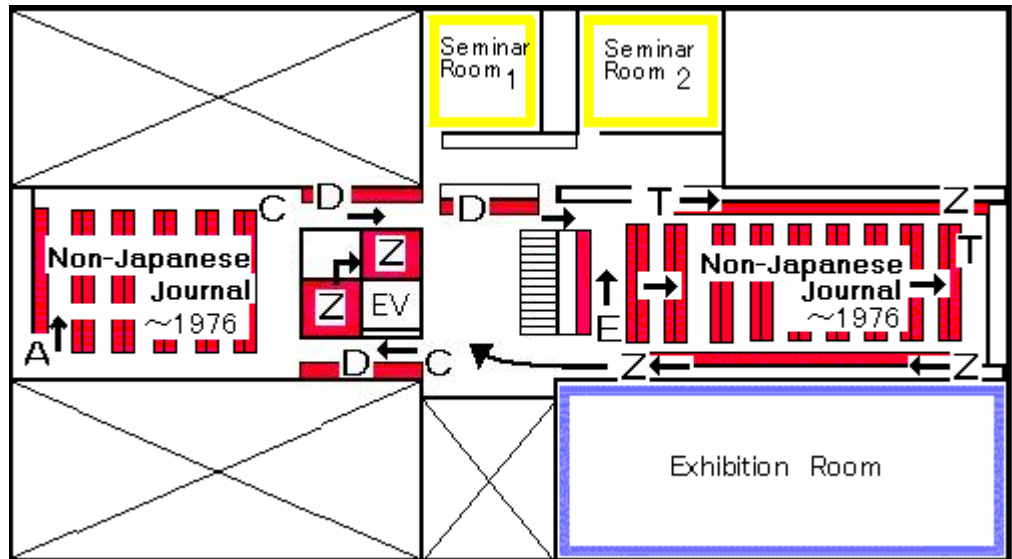

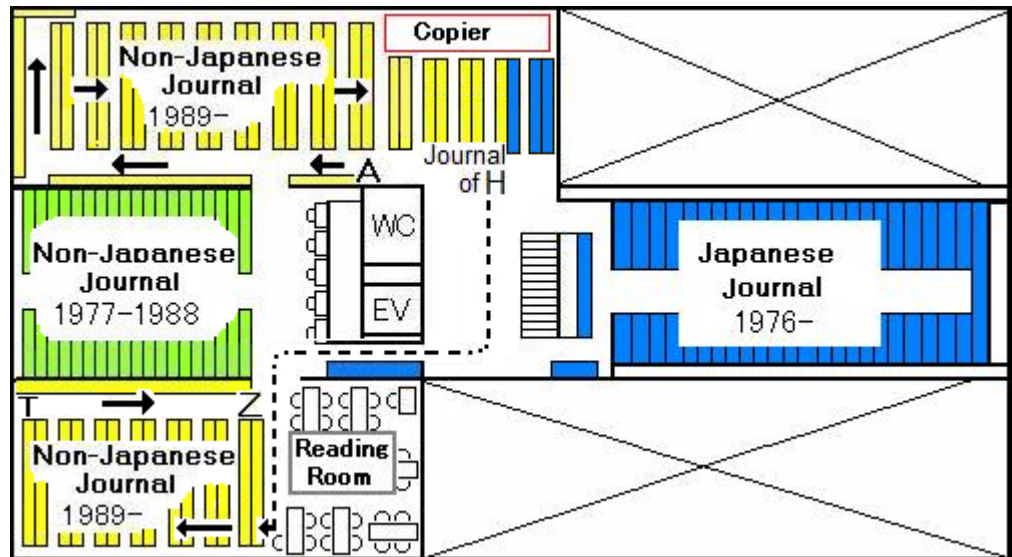
