序

ヤング・リーダーズ・プログラム (YLP) は、アジア諸国等の指導者として活躍が期待される行政官、経済人等の若手指導者を、わが国の大学院等に招へいし、1年間で修士学位を授与する留学プログラムである。国際的な視野にたった専門領域の知識見識を高めるだけでなく、同時に日本の社会文化に対する理解を深めてもらう機会を提供する。このプログラムを通して日本および参加国間において絆が強まることが期待される。

現在、YLP として4大学5コースがあり、名古屋大学大学院医学系研究科は、このうちの医療行政コースを担当している。この医療行政コースは、平成15年(2003年)に開設され、伊藤勝基先生が初代教授に就任した。平成18年(2006年)に坂本純一先生、平成24年(2012年)に浜島信之先生が教授を引き継ぎ、令和3年(2021年)に4代目教授として山本が就任した。

2025年9月末までに本コースで修士を取得した学生は、16カ国227名にのぼる(うち19名はJDS/JICAの奨学制度による)。この中から更に進学し、22名が名古屋大学で博士号を取得した。うち18名は、当医療行政学講座で学位を取得した。多くの卒業生は、各政府においても、指導的役割を果たしており、高官や国会議員となった者もいる。名古屋大学同窓会海外支部は、現在、14カ国で開設されており、YLP卒業生はそのうち1カ国(ラオス)の支部長を務めている。YLP医療行政コースの発展を願い、2013年10月17日に10周年記念式展、2018年9月26日に15周年記念式展を、さらに、2023年12月4日には20周年記念式展を、文部科学省、外務省、厚生労働省からの来賓を招き開催した。

この業績集は、主に2016年から2025年までの成果をまとめたものである。2003年から医療行政学の教授、准教授、講師、助教として在籍した教員は17名である。本業績集に掲載した教員の論文は、各教員が在任して

Preface

The Young Leaders' Program (YLP) is an academic program sponsored by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sport, Science and Technology of Japan, to invite young administrators mainly from Asian countries. A one-year master course is provided with the expectation that the students will deepen their knowledge and understanding, not only of the international perspective of their professional fields, but also of the socio-cultural systems of Japan, and become exponents in their respective countries who will serve to bridge both nations in future.

Currently, four universities provide five courses of YLP. Nagoya University Graduate School of Medicine started the YLP Healthcare Administration course in 2003, with the thoughtful leadership of Prof. Katsuki Ito. I became the fourth professor of the course in 2021 following Prof. Junichi Sakamoto (2006-2012) and Prof. Nobuyuki Hamajima (2012-2021).

By September 2025, 227 participants from 16 countries graduated, 19 of whom were JDS/JICA sponsored. Twenty-two of them attained PhDs from Nagoya University, including 18 conferred from the Department of Healthcare Administration. In addition, many YLP graduates are currently playing a leading role at the core of their homeland healthcare policy making sectors, with some serving at a ministerial level and some working as a diet member. Out of 14 branches of the Nagoya University Alumni Association organized abroad, one (Lao PDR) headed by YLP graduates.

Ceremonies to mark the 10th, 15th, and 20th anniversaries of the establishment of the course were held on October 17, 2013, September 26, 2018, and December 4, 2023,


