- A special Master's Degree program
- Duration : One year
- Expected participants : Promising young (≤40)
 public officials working for governmental
 health sector with ≥5 years of working experience
- Full scholarship by the Japanese government
- Language : The curriculum is taught entirely in English (IELTS ≥6 or TOEFL iBT ≥80).
- You can : be a future national leader, form
 international friendly relationship, and improve
 the quality of public policy of your country
- Graduates: 215 (Generation 20) * As of Sep. 2023
