


# A & E Department in UHC/


Divided into Resuscitation, Major, Minor and Paediatric










# Haematology Department in VHC

Outpatient clinic and stuff rooms are located next to ward.



#2: 60s P Recurrent Multiple Myeloma


planned for haematopoietic stem cell transplant

with chemotherapy-related sepsis


# Findings in Haematology

### UHC snapshots 2 Corridors to each departments






# Pathology Department in UHC

Handle all laboratory tests using biological specimens requested from not only other departments but GPs



Retrospective research of approximate150 MM cases






On molecular analysis of lung cancer specimensCollaborative work with a postgraduate student
