Clinical Courses and Elective Rotations In line with the University's Diploma Policy, each student is subject to individualized evaluation and supervision throughout their clinical clerkship. The breakdown of the clerkship evaluation components and their respective weightings is as follows: clinical performance 30%, subject examination 30%, case preparation 30%, and OSCE 10%.

Taro's clinical performance was assessed on a Pass/Fail basis, taking into account both his case write-up and the clinical evaluations provided by the preceptors in various departments. The final grade was determined by combining these evaluations with the results of the examinations, as shown in the graph below. Notably, he passed all examinations on his first attempt, with the majority of subjects achieving at least a grade of "B" or higher, indicating a solid academic foundation.

For example, during his elective rotation, Nagoya Taro gained experience in both the internal medicine department at a well-regarded hospital and the family medicine department at a prestigious university. In his rotation at the hospital, he was involved in conducting thorough patient interviews, performing physical examinations, and delivering clinical presentations. He also contributed by preparing a detailed review on diabetic ketoacidosis, demonstrating his ability to synthesize complex clinical information. In the family medicine rotation, he observed his attending physician's daily practices and participated in clinical discussions. His ability to communicate effectively with patients was evident throughout both experiences, as he displayed excellent bedside manner and formed meaningful connections with patients and their families. His compassionate and



empathetic approach to care earned him praise from both patients and healthcare professionals alike.
