Cochran Collection (EBSCOhost)

- Cochrane Database for Joint Planning
- Supporting the practice of EBM (Evidence Based Medicine)
- Limited to well-selected data with less numbers of recording
- Also use in systematic review

Cochran Collection

Cochrane Database of Systematic Reviews	Full texts of systematic reviews available Updated four times a year
Cochrane Central Register of Controlled Trials	Bibliographic information database for controlled clinical trials
Cochrane Methodology Register	Bibliographic database on methods of controlled clinical trials
Cochrane Clinical Answers	Includes clinical questions, concise answers, and evidence can be drilled down and investigated from relevant Cochrane reviews.



Cochrane Database of Systematic Reviews contains full text articles, as well as protocols focusing on systematic reviews of randomised controlled trials, each too small to produce reliable results individually.

The *Cochrane Methodology Register* (CMR) is a bibliography of publications which report on methodological research. The database contains studies of methods used in reviews and more general methodological research. The database also contains bibliographic details and, in some cases, a summary of the article. CMR is produced by the UK Cochrane Centre.

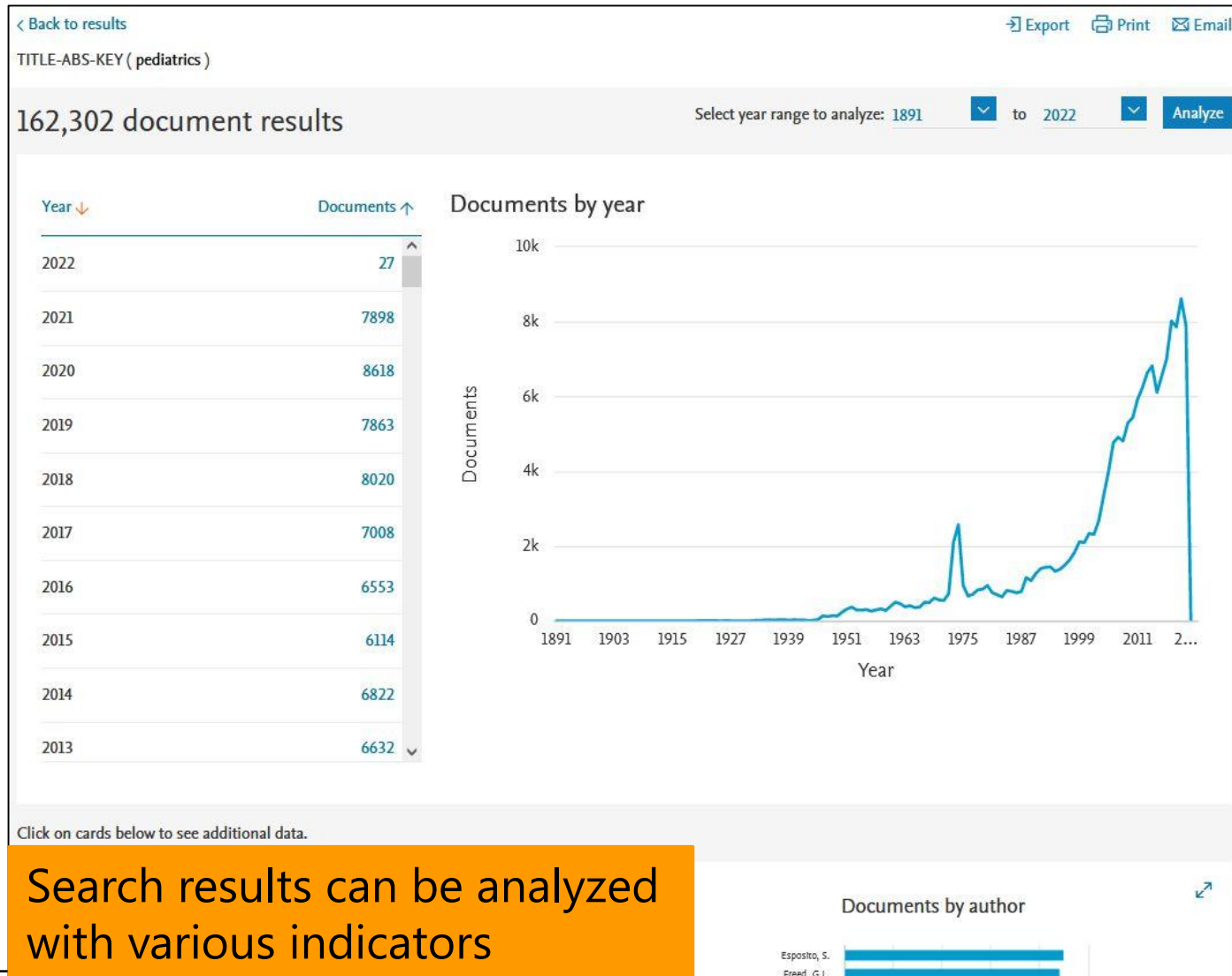

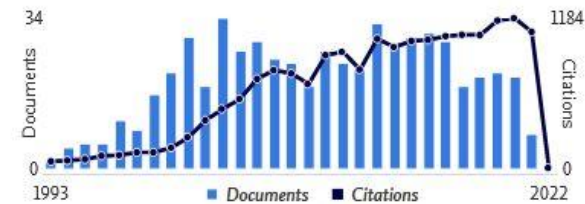
